

1 Matthew 14:14
When Jesus landed and saw a large crowd, he had compassion on them and healed their sick.

Who do you know who shows great compassion to others?

Ask God to help you have compassion like He does on others.

5 Matthew 21:14
The blind and the lame came to him at the temple, and he healed them.

What does Jesus' healing of the blind and the lame have to do with you?

Ask God to help you to walk as Jesus walked and to see as Jesus saw.

9 John 4:34
"My food," said Jesus, "is to do the will of Him who sent me and to finish His work."

Are you doing the will of God and His work with your life and time?

Ask God to help you commit yourself more fully to do His will and His work.

13 Matthew 20:34 Jesus had compassion on them and touched their eyes. Immediately they received their sight and followed him.

Does genuine compassion for people bring action?

Ask God to help you take action when He moves in your heart.

2 2 Corinthians 8:9
For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you through his poverty might become rich.

How has the grace of Christ affected your family?

Thank God for His amazing grace.

6 John 9:4-5
As long as it is day, we must do the works of him who sent me. Night is coming, when no one can work. While I am in the world, I am the light of the world.

In what ways is Jesus light in your life and family?

Ask God to help you see the light of Jesus and walk in it daily.

10 Romans 12:10
Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves.

What are some ways to honor others above yourself?

Ask God to help you truly be devoted to others in love.

14 Mark 3:35
Whoever does God's will is my brother and sister and mother.

How important is doing God's will to having a relationship with Jesus?

Thank God that you can do His will today because you love Jesus.

3 Isaiah 40:11
Like a shepherd He will tend His flock, In His arm He will gather the lambs And carry them in His bosom; He will gently lead the nursing ewes.

Why is the picture of a shepherd so powerful in this verse?

Thank God for all the ways He cares for you!

7 John 10:37-38
Do not believe me unless I do the works of my Father. But if I do them, even though you do not believe me, believe the works, that you may know and understand that the Father is in me, and I in the Father.

What are some works of the Father that Jesus does?

Thank God that He is always at work around you.

11 Matthew 11:28-30
Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light.

What is the best thing about this invitation from Jesus?

Thank God for His rest.

15 John 6:27
Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him God the Father has placed his seal of approval.

How often do you think of what matters for eternity?

Ask God to help you make eternal things the priority in your life.

4 Hebrews 4:15
For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are— yet he did not sin.

What hope do you have over sin in you?

Thank God that Jesus intercedes for you in your weaknesses.

8 Romans 5:8
But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

Does love always demonstrate itself?

Thank God that He loves us and demonstrates His love clearly to us.

12 Matthew 15:32
Jesus called his disciples to him and said, "I have compassion for these people; they have already been with me three days and have nothing to eat. I do not want to send them away hungry, or they may collapse on the way."

How does Jesus minister to the crowd of people?

Ask God to help you have compassion for those in need.

16 John 6:28-29
Then they asked him, "What must we do to do the works God requires?" Jesus answered, "The work of God is this: to believe in the one he has sent."

Why is faith so important in doing what God requires?

Ask God to help you walk with Him by faith every day.





17 Ephesians 2:10
For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.

What are some of the good works God re-created you in Jesus to do?

Give thanks for all things.s.

21 Romans 12:1
Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.

How do you worship God alone, and how do you worship with other believers?

Ask God to help you worship Him in holiness and submission to His will.

25 Matthew 28:19-20
Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.

How important is it to make disciples?

Thank God that you are called to make disciples.

29 Galatians 5:13-14
You, my brothers and sisters, were called to be free. But do not use your freedom to indulge the flesh; rather, serve one another humbly in love. For the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

Why do we want to use our freedom to serve ourself?

Thank God for your freedom in Christ.

18 Matthew 7:24
Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.

Why doesn't everyone stand fast when storms hit?

Ask God to help you build your life on Jesus Christ.

22 1 Peter 4:9
Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

Is hospitality easy or hard for you, and why?

Ask God to help you offer hospitality willingly and with joy.

26 Romans 10:15
And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

Why is the Gospel we are sent to tell others "Good News?"

Ask God to help you share the good news with others each day.

30 Matthew 20:27-28
...and whoever wishes to be first among you shall be your slave; just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.

How is being first in God's kingdom different?

Thank Jesus for dying for you and the whole world.

19 Zechariah 8:16-17
"These are the things you are to do: Speak the truth to each other, and render true and sound judgment in your courts; do not plot evil against each other, and do not love to swear falsely. I hate all this," declares the LORD.

Why do people sometimes do the things that God hates?

Ask God to help you do the things He loves and avoid the things He hates.

23 Romans 12:13
Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality.

Why is sharing with others and practicing hospitality important for believers today?

Thank God that He has given you things you can share with others.

27 Romans 12:21
Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

Who do you know who is an example of sincerity and truth?

Ask God to help you live in all of your relationships with sincerity and truth.

31 Mark 10:13-16
People were bringing little children to Jesus for him to place his hands on them, but the disciples rebuked them. When Jesus saw this, he was indignant. He said to them, "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them, for the kingdom of God belongs to such as these. Truly I tell you, anyone who will not receive the kingdom of God like a little child will never enter it." And he took the children in his arms, placed his hands on them and blessed them.

How are you at blessing children & others?

Thank God that He loves to be kind and to pour out blessings on us.

20 Luke 6:30-31
Give to everyone who asks you, and if anyone takes what belongs to you, do not demand it back. Do to others as you would have them do to you.

Why is the "Golden Rule" so hard to follow sometimes?

Ask God to help you live by His Golden Rule always.

24 Mathew 16:24
Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."

Why can't you be Jesus' disciple without denying yourself, taking up your cross, and following Him?

Ask God to help you to deny yourself and follow Jesus every day.

28 1 Peter 4:10
Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

What are some gifts you have that you can use to serve others as God's steward?

Thank God that He has given you gifts to use for Him in serving others.
