Psalm 29:2

---  
God is holy. This means God is totally good & unique (transcendent)

John 1:4  
In him was life, and the life was the light of men.

---  
How is the life and light Jesus gives different from anything else?

---  
Ask God to help you walk in His light every day.

1 John 4:9  
In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him.

---  
Why was our life before Jesus not good enough, so that in love God intervened on our behalf?

---  
Thank God for how much He loved you, that He sent His only Son so that you could live through Him.

13

Hebrews 12:2  
Looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

---  
Why is it important to keep our eyes, our focus, on Jesus every day?

---  
Pray the verse after this one, "Consider Him who endured such opposition from sinful men, so that you will not grow weary or lose heart" (Heb. 12:3).

Psalm 18:3  
I call upon the LORD, who is worthy to be praised, and I am saved from my enemies.

---  
Why is God worthy to be praised?

---  
Thank the God for His worthiness.

6

1 John 5:12

---  
What is different about the eternal life Jesus gives from the physical life of earth?

---  
Thank God for His eternal life, that never ends.

Matthew 21:5

---  
What do you find curious about Jesus entering as King while riding a young donkey?

---  
Ask the Lord to help you be humble in your dealings with your family and others.

Revelation 19:16  
On his robe and on his thigh he has a name written, King of kings and Lord of lords.

---  
How do current world leaders and situations look different in light of this verse?

---  
Thank God that He reigns over all.

John 11:25-26  
Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live, and everyone who lives and believes in me shall never die."

---

---  
Ask God to help you find your life in Him.

Galatians 2:20

---

---

---

---  
In addition to Jesus, what are some other things that never change?

---  
Thank God that you can trust Him to be consistent and faithful.

John 14:6

---  
What are some false ways people may believe they can get to heaven/God?

---

John 10:10

**Luke 24:6-7**  
He is not here, but has risen. Remember how he told you, while he was still in Galilee, that the Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men and be crucified and on the third day rise.

---  
How surprised would you be if you went to anoint a dead body with spices and perfumes but encountered the risen Savior?

---  
Thank God that we do not honor a dead hero but worship a living Lord!

**Hebrews 11:6**  
And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.

---  
In what ways are faith in God under attack in our world?

---  
Thank God for the difference faith makes in our world view.

**Romans 15:13**  
May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope.

---  
Share some of the aspects of hope that you have because of God's Spirit.

---  
Thank God for the hope you have because you have His Spirit in you.

29

**Ephesians 3:16**  
That according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being.

---  
When is a time that the strength of the Spirit was very real to you?

---  
Ask God to fill you and strengthen you by His Spirit.

**Psalm 23:3**  
He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

---  
To be restored means to be made right. In what ways do you need to be restored today?

---  
Ask the Lord to restore your soul.

**Luke 15:18-20**  
I will arise and go to my father, and I will say to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son..." And he arose and came to his father. But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and felt compassion, and ran and embraced him and kissed him.

---  
What does this parable teach us about God?

---  
Thank God for His compassion and readiness to receive the straying. Pray for anyone you know who may be straying from the Father.

**John 6:63**  
It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh is no help at all. The words that I have spoken to you are spirit and life.

---  
Why is the myth that you can find life through your flesh (the things of this world) so persistent when the Word of God is so clear that life only comes through the Spirit?

---  
Ask God to help you trust His Word, the ultimate truth of the universe.

30

**Galatians 5:22-23**  
But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

---  
Which feature of the fruit of the Spirit flows most easily through you, and which feature do you struggle to show in your life?

---  
Ask God to help you live in the fullness of the fruit His Spirit brings.

19

**Acts 3:20-21**  
That times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that he may send the Christ appointed for you, Jesus, whom heaven must receive until the time for restoring all the things about which God spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets long ago.

---  
What needs refreshing and restoring from the Lord today?

---  
Ask God to bring His refreshing and restoring to our world.

23

**1 John 5:3-5**  
For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world—our faith. Who is it that overcomes the world except the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God.

---  
What are some features of the world that you work by faith to overcome?

---  
Ask God to help you be an overcomer by faith in Him.

27

**1 John 4:13**  
By this we know that we abide in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit.

---  
What makes fellowship with Jesus that the Spirit ignites so vital in your daily life?

---  
Thank God for the fellowship His Spirit ignites and empowers in us.

**Revelation 21:3-5**  
And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Behold, the dwelling place of God is with man...He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away." And he who was seated on the throne said, "Behold, I am making all things new." ...

---  
How important is the hope contained in this promise for the future from God?

---  
Thank God for His sure hope in the Lord Jesus.

**Acts 1:8**  
But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

---  
In what ways is the Spirit working in you to empower your witness for Jesus?

---  
Ask God to empower you to be His witness for Jesus.

**Acts 8:26-27**  
Likewise the Spirit helps us in our weakness. For we do not know what to pray for as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words. And he who searches hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

---
